• Affirmative


 <u>TO BE</u>	 <u>HAVE GOT</u>
I am (I'm)	I have got (I've got)
You are (You're)	You have got (You've got)
He is (He's)	He has got (He's got)
She is (She's)	She has got (She's got)
It is (It's)	It has got (It's got)
We are (We're)	We have got (We've got)
You are (You're)	You have got (You've got)
They are (They're)	They have got (They've got)

I am.  Am I? Yes, I am. No, I'm not.	He/she/It is.  Is he/she/it? Yes, (he/she/it) is. No, (he/she/it) isn't.	I have got.  Have I got? Yes, I have. No, I haven't.	He/she/It has got.  Has he/she/It got? Yes, (he/she/it) has. No, (he/she/it) hasn't.
You are.  Are you? Yes, you are. No, you aren't.	We/You/They are.  Are we/you/they? Yes, (we/you/they) are. No, (we/you/they) aren't.	You have got.  Have you got? Yes, you have. No, you haven't.	We/You/They have got.  Have we/you/they got? Yes, (we/you/they) have. No, (we/you/they) haven't.
