Verbs/Nouns ending in:	* 3rd person singular verbs * plural nouns	Examples
"CH" - "SH" - "S" - "SS" - "X" - "O"	+ "ES"	(n) Peach-Peaches (v) Teach-Teaches (n) Bush-Bushes (v) Wash-Washes (v) Kiss-Kisses (v) Do-Does
"O"	Drops "Y" + "IES"	(v) Study-Studies (n) Baby-Babies (v) Hurry-Hurries (n) Lorry-Lorries
VOWEL + "Y"	+ "S"	(v) Stay-Stays (n) Academy-Academies (v) Play-Plays

ING

	Changes	Examples
Normally "ING" is added - After "X", "Y", "W"	+ING	(v) Pay-Paying (v) Snow-Snowing (v) Fix-Fixing
Verbs ending in: "E" except "EE"	Drop "E" + "ING"	(v) Drive-Driving (v) Write-Writing (v) Leave-Leaving (v) Smoke-Smoking
Verbs ending in: "IE"	Change "ie" for "Y"	(v) Die-Dying (v) Lie-Lying
ONE SYLLABLE VERBS 2 consonants or 2 vowels together (do not repeat last letter) *Consonant = (c) *Vowel = (v)	<p>S W I M M I N G C < V < C + Consonant</p> <p>E A T I N G V < V < C + Vowel</p> <p>S E E I N G C < V < V + Vowel</p>	(v) Cut-Cutting (v) Steal-Stealing (v) Let-Letting (V) Read-Reading (v) Sit-Sitting (v) Lend-Lending
TWO SYLLABLE VERBS Verbs ending in: "L"	Doble "L" in British English. +ING in American English.	(v) Travel-Travelling (v) Quarrel-Quarrelling (v) Model-Modelling *Americans say 'Traveling', 'Modeling', Quarreling...
TWO SYLLABLE VERBS Verbs ending in a stress vowel	Doble the last letter before ING. (Be*gin) (For*get)	(v) Begin-Beginning (v) Forget-Forgetting

"ED"

	Changes	Examples
Most verbs	+ "ED"	(v) Want-Wanted (v) Ask-Asked (v) Roll-Rolled
Verbs ending in: "E"	+ "D"	(v) Live-Lived (v) Use-Used (v) Love-Loved
Verbs ending in: CONSONANT + "Y"	Drop "Y" + "IED"	(v) Study-Studied (v) Hurry-Hurried
ONE SYLLABLE VERBS 2 consonants or 2 vowels together (do not repeat last letter) *Consonant = (c) *Vowel = (v)	<p>S T O P P E D C < V < C + Consonant</p> <p>P L A N N E D C < V < C + Consonant</p>	(v) Stop-Stopped (v) Plan-Planned (v) Rob-Robbed
